

John was born on October 7, 1951, in Seymour. He was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame by friend Billy Joel on March 10, 2008. Mellencamp also was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame on June 14, 2018. A tour of Mellencamp landmarks is available


